Booking Confirmation

All bookings are subject to confirmation and full payment, unless alternative payment terms have been approved by Coromandel Discovery. Confirmed reservations are required for all services.

All payments are to be made in New Zealand dollars and must include payment for any bank charges incurred.

All retail prices are in \$NZD and include GST (15%). Prices are subject to change without notice.

If you have made payment by Credit Card, the name that will appear on your statement will be Bush e Bikes t/a Coromandel Discovery.

All bookings are for a specific date and are subject to any terms and conditions notified at the time of booking/

The following age determinations apply to our fare structure however full fare is payable for unaccompanied children. Full contact details of caregiver required.

Children

Travel Disruptions

However, Coromandel Discovery will use its best endeavours to find a replacement travel service or accommodation facility to ensure the comfort and safety of its passengers during this disrupted period, if available.

Refund Policy

All prepaid bookings with Coromandel Discovery are refundable in the event that Coromandel Discovery cancels the service.

Reservations may be transferred or refunded up to 48 hours prior to the commencement of the planned service.

No refunds will be given for cancellations within 48 hours of the departure.

Right of Refusal
